### Work at QHS

#### Available non-teaching roles

- Student Support Officer: you will need a degree or qualification in social work or mental health and wellbeing or considerable work experience in the field of youth wellbeing services. Recruitment process is conducted by central staffing but the School Principal can talk about the position with you.
- School Learning and Support

  Officers: preference given to people who already have undertaken a certificate 2 in teacher aid/support at TAFE. Good literacy and numeracy skills and ability to work positively with students essential.
- Full time administration support: faculty support through use of technology, data entry and formatting of materials.
- Part time position to assist staff with variation of routine paperwork and risk assessments for excursion and incursions.

Anyone interested should contact the school and talk with the Principal or School Administration Manager.

All staff in schools require a NSW Working with Children Check and will also have additional screening for working directly with students.

# Staffing changes impacts the timetable

Changes were made to the timetable to accommodate a reduction in the number of teachers we currently have in the school. A significant number of staff have taken up new positions in other systems and industries. As yet we have been unable to fill these positions and are operating on a much-reduced staffing capacity. This necessitated a major overhaul of our timetable and at this point we are unable to take out of area enrolments.

There are some positions where we have struggled to get consistency of teachers for this year. Some of these positions have been advertised several times with no result. At assembly this week, we asked all students to be mindful of this and focus on our expected behaviours as Respectful, Responsible Learners.

We are working under less than optimum conditions and we need to treat each other with respect allowing them to learn and teach.

At the core of our decision making is to focus on day-to-day operations and trying to continue to offer the enrichment and engagement activities of sport, cultural, academic and recreational opportunities that benefit our students.

We will strive to communicate this information to our parent community through your provided email and facebook. Where staff have capacity, we shall share our students' efforts Via Facebook. Parents who are not receiving emails should check the school has the best email contact.

### Are you interested in working in our school?

One full-time and one-part time position open for people with good technology and administration skills until the end of December 2023. Our school has funding for an additional 1.7 School Administration positions commencing early next term for the remainder of 2023. Applicants will need to have good IT skills covering Microsoft, Sharepoint, Google Apps and be able to pick up new systems quickly. These roles will be directly supporting teachers and faculties with online templates for teaching programmes and supporting the organisation of variations of routine related to sport and daily operations. ### Proposed change in finishing times of the school

#### NAIDOC STEM Workshops—Soar with Stem

The combined Queanbeyan Network Schools are excited to be holding a STEM week for this year's NAIDOC Week. Tuesday, 29 August to Thursday 31 August 2023.

2400 students from across 18 schools will participate in a range of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander STEM focused activities and investigate post school destination options and supports available within our region.

Students from Years 5 to Year 8 will participate in workshops and students from Years 9 and 10 will support workshop delivery and visit the careers expo. The expo will expose students to local options for tertiary and skilled training beyond formal school education. Parent volunteers with a NSW Working with Children check are most welcome to support this program by helping to run a BBQ to feed all visiting students.

#### Cost of Living impacts our school community


We are very aware that many families are struggling with the cost of living. Recent invoices sent home for school elective fees for the first
